Aron John Bierl, 33, of Nora Springs, died peacefully in his sleep Wednesday, February 5, 2020, at his home.

A Celebration of Life will be from 1:00-4:00 p.m. Saturday, March 7, 2020, at Sheckler Colonial Chapel, 114 N. Hawkeye Ave., Nora Springs.

Aron was born July 5, 1986, the son of Ronald B. and Patricia M. (Sletten) Bierl in Mason City. He graduated from Nora Springs-Rock Falls High School and later received a degree from Kaplan University. He worked various jobs throughout his life, including as a Cerro Gordo County Jailer, a welder, and most recently as a truck driver.

Aron was a proud high school wrestler who qualified for state three times; placing his junior and senior years and was a member of the 100 Pin Club. He was extremely enthusiastic about many sports and hobbies including: football, target shooting, fishing, hunting, and riding his motorcycle, and watching & quoting movies. Aron had a beautiful singing voice and was not shy to begin singing anywhere, even if he didn't know all the words. His favorite music genre was country western and he was learning how to play the guitar. He had an infectious, deep and booming laugh. He was a big guy, but always permeated love and gentleness. He was proud to participate in marching band, and loved playing the drums. Aron had a lot of love to give everyone. His dog, family, and special nieces and nephew received most of that love. Above all the greatest and most special job and title he ever held was that of "Dad." He was honored to be a dad, and any time he spent with his son Cael was treasured. His personality burned bright, and he never did anything half way. His family would joke that he had ants in his pants and was always going like the Energizer Bunny.

Aron is survived by his son, Cael Aron Bierl of Mason City; mother, Patricia (Jack Bahnsen) Bierl of Nora Springs; father, Ron Bierl of Nora Springs; sisters, Sara (Joshua) Spieker of Cedar Falls and Emilee Kofoot of Algona; five nieces and one nephew; several aunts, uncles, and cousins, and special friend Tina La Lone.
